- Council was given a memo from the Sewer Authority. DELCORA has issued an Amendment to the 537 Plan asking all municipalities to pass a Resolution on September to authorize DELCORA to sell the assets to AQUA.
- Mr. Lebold and Mr. Kelly have been in discussions with Edgemont Township regarding the intersection at Providence and Bishop Hollow Roads. There is a 249 apartment complex in Edgemont that has been approved. Edgemont has asked the developer to look at that intersection for improvements which would need to be permitted by our Township. Discussions are ongoing.


Ms. Heupler noted that that intersection is one of the areas of concern in the Comprehensive Plan.
