State law requires that owners of dogs, three months and older, get a license every year, or have a lifetime license. Failure to license a dog is a summary offense that can result in a maximum fine of \$300 per unlicensed dog. State law also requires that dogs have a current rabies vaccination.

### Traffic Calming

Traffic Calming has become a hot topic. The term traffic calming refers to three activities known as the three "E's": Education, Enforcement and Engineering. Education refers to the dissemination of safety information to the public, enforcement is police enforcement of speed limits and other traffic control devices, and engineering involves changes in road design that support safer driving.

The goals of traffic calming are to encourage "self-policing" and to make streets safer for a variety of reasons. Implementing traffic calming devices requires engineered studies, creating a scored evaluation system based upon speed, volume, crashes, proximity to schools, pedestrian generators and pedestrian fatalities. This scored evaluation is based upon procedures required by PennDOT and must be complied with to reduce potential liability on behalf of the municipality.

The Township goal for traffic calming is to provide a safe environment for pedestrians, preserve the residential character of all neighborhoods and to improve the overall quality of life.
