



LEAF COLLECTION is every Wednesday from October 3 - December 19, 2018. They can be placed curbside in an approved biodegradable, compostable bags, or approved 55 gallon container.

YARD WASTE occurs the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of every month throughout the year. Place at curbside in approved paper biodegradable, compostable bags, approved 55 gallon container or tied into bundles no more than 3 feet in length and weighing no more than 30 lbs. Yard waste may consist of tree trimmings, shrubbery, leaves, general yard and garden residues/wastes and other similar material but specifically excluding grass clippings (grass clippings can be included as part of your regular trash).

The Township was recently presented with a Certificate of Recognition from the Pennsylvania Department of Health, recognizing the Township's efforts to protect the health of children and families by preventing tobacco usage in all Township parks through the "Young Lungs at Play" program.
