On behalf of the entire staff, I would like to express our best wishes and hopes that 2019 will be a good year for everyone.

In addition to the improvements being undertaken by PECO and AQUA to their existing utilities, the Township continues to tackle improvements to our aging infrastructure system and the maintenance of Township roads.

With the completion of the recent sanitary sewer extension and RT. 252 widening project, we now can look forward to the improvements to the Springton Dam, also known as the Geist Reservoir. This is a PennDOT project, which will replace the bridge that carries Route 252 (Palmer's Mill Road) over the Springton Reservoir. The primary goal of the project is to address existing deficiencies with the portion of Route 252 over the dam and provide increased span length to accommodate AQUA's future enlargement of the Springton Reservoir. This project is expected to begin this Spring and be completed in the fall of 2021.

As always, we value the suggestions and opinions we receive from our residents and welcome the opportunity to talk with you at sometime during the year. Our community is always best served when the residents actively participate and openly communicate their ideas on ways to improve our community. We welcome your continued interest in helping us to make Upper Providence the best place in which to live and raise a family. Thank you so much for all your continued support and encouragement.
