Ms. Vicki also presents an interactive puppet show and storytime at least one Friday a month. This fall, we have added a monthly Tuesday evening puppet show and storytime. PAWS for Reading has returned for the first and third Wednesdays at 6:30pm. Children ages 5 and up can sign up for a 10-minute slot to read to a specially-trained therapy dog.
