One of our major cost areas is the maintenance of our collection system pipes, manholes, grinder pumps, and central pump stations. In recent years, these costs have increased in part because of the placement of material into the sewer system which cause blockages and equipment failures.

The following is a list of the most common items that should not be placed in the sewer system.

Glass

Metal

**Abrasive materials including
Gravel, Sand, Aquarium Stone,
and Coffee Grounds**

Seafood shells

Socks, rags, cloths

Plastic

Sanitary napkins

Disposable diapers

Kitty litter

Flammable materials

Cooking oil, lubricating oil,

Paint

Strong chemicals

Gasoline or diesel fuel

Storm water

**Wipes of all kinds
(and other products marked "flushable")**
