WHEREAS, Fred Mason served as a certified CISM (Critical Incident Stress Management) officer and thereby served in a supporting role for police, fire and ems personnel who experienced extremely stressful incidents or experiences; and

WHEREAS, Fred Mason was the recipient of numerous awards, accolades and commendations over his career including in 2016 when Officer Mason was the recipient of the prestigious "Foot Soldier of Justice Award" given by the NAACP in recognition of his bravery and dedication in law enforcement; and


WHEREAS, Fred Mason retired from Township employment as of March 9, 2021 after having served the citizens of Upper Providence Township for over thirty-one years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Upper Providence Township recognizes that the time of retirement is a suitable moment at which to acknowledge said service.

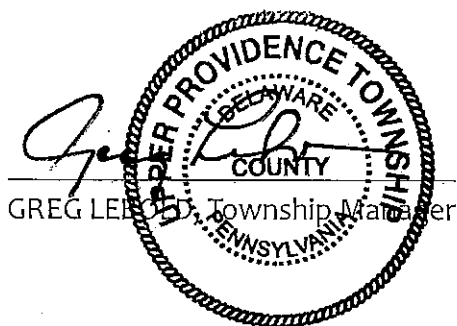
