WHEREAS, In January of 2008, Detective Sergeant Langdale returned to the criminal investigations division where he stayed the remainder of his career; and

WHEREAS, Detective Sergeant Langdale was the recipient of numerous awards, accolades and commendations over his career; and

WHEREAS, Detective Sergeant Langdale was the lead investigator on several high profile cases not only in Upper Providence Township but also throughout the County of Delaware; and

WHEREAS, Michael Langdale retired from Township employment as of March 9, 2021 after having served the citizens of Upper Providence Township for over twenty years; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Upper Providence Township recognizes that the time of retirement is a suitable moment at which to acknowledge said service.


