WHEREAS, Robert William Haines has earnestly and faithfully served the citizens of Upper Providence Township since October 1986, when he was hired as a Patrol Officer with the Upper Providence Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Robert William Haines was promoted to Patrol Corporal on October 1, 1988 where he assumed a supervisory role on his platoon; and

WHEREAS, in 2002 Robert William Haines was assigned to criminal investigations where he served as a Detective for the Upper Providence Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2005 Haines was promoted to the rank of Patrol Sergeant taking responsibility for the supervision of all four Police Department platoons; and

WHEREAS, in 2010 Sergeant Haines was named second in command of the police department in the absence of the Chief Of Police; and

WHEREAS, among the numerous awards, accolades and commendations Sergeant Haines was recognized over his career, on February 6th, 1999, Sergeant Haines was awarded a commendation for Heroism due to his heroic efforts in saving a woman from a burning building at the Hunt Club Apartments; and

WHEREAS, Robert William Haines retired from Township employment as of March 9, 2021 after having served the citizens of Upper Providence Township for thirty-five years; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Upper Providence Township recognizes that the time of retirement is a suitable moment at which to acknowledge said service.
