**RESOLUTION ENDING THE DISASTER EMERGENCY
DECLARATION, RESOLUTION 2020-13, FOR UPPER PROVIDENCE
TOWNSHIP AT THE END OF THE DAY ON MAY 11, 2023.**

WHEREAS, on or about March 6, 2020, the State of Pennsylvania declared a disaster emergency throughout the State of Pennsylvania due to the COVID 19 pandemic, and;

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Township Council of Upper Providence Township declared the existence of a disaster emergency in Upper Providence and quickly implemented policy measures they considered necessary to mitigate the pandemic's impact on its community; and;

WHEREAS the virus has no longer significant potential to endanger the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Upper Providence, and;

WHEREAS, according to key data for monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic level in Delaware County provided by the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is low; and;


WHEREAS, on April 10, 2023, the President signed H.J.Res.7. into law, which, effective May 11, 2023, terminates the national COVID-19 emergency,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Township Council of Upper Providence Township does hereby declare the end of the disaster emergency related to COVID-19 pandemic in Upper Providence Township;

The End of the Disaster Emergency declared for the Township shall take effect immediately.
