**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING UPPER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP TO APPLY FOR A
2023 TRANSPORTATION SET-ASIDE PROGRAM (TASA) GRANT**

WHEREAS, Upper Providence Township of Delaware County is in need of the improvement and enhancement of pedestrian connectivity and the overall pedestrian safety surrounding the Rose Tree Elementary School; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include the installation of two (2) pedestrian push button signals (intersection of Sandybank Road/2nd Avenue and N. Providence Road and School Lane), the installation/rehabilitation of ADA handicap ramps, sidewalk and curb restoration and installation, pavement restoration and erosion control stabilization along 1st Avenue, 2nd Avenue, Evans Road, Maple Avenue and School Lane.

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Township conducted a Sidewalk Feasibility Study to discuss design options, pedestrian traffic analysis and construction costs and preliminary plans have been prepared for the proposed 'Pedestrian Safety Sidewalk Improvements Project',


WHEREAS, the **Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA)** provides funding for projects and activities defined as transportation alternatives, including Safe to School projects.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Officials of Upper Providence Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, in regular session on the 13th day of July 2023, and hereby made a decision for a TASA grant application in the amount of \$386,350.00 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the enhancement of pedestrian connectivity and safety surrounding the Rose Tree Elementary School.

THEREFORE, be it FURTHER RESOLVED that Upper Providence Township does hereby designate James P. Kelly, P.E., Township Engineer, to assist in obtaining the requested grant.


