A Resolution authorizing Upper Providence Township to apply for a 2024 Automated Red-Light Enforcement (ARLE) grant to improve School Zone designation through striping, signing, or signal improvements along Rt. 252 between Preston Road and Sandy Bank Road

WHEREAS, Upper Providence Township of Delaware County needs to improve and enhance the School Zone surrounding the Rose Tree Elementary School and the Walden School; and,


WHEREAS, in February 2024, the Township conducted a meeting and walk-through with two representatives from PennDOT to discuss pedestrian safety when crossing Rt. 252 between Preston Road and Sandy Bank Road especially during school hours; and

WHEREAS, PennDOT's **Automated Red-Light Enforcement (ARLE)** grant program provides funding for professional services to perform traffic signals and related studies, crosswalk striping, and pedestrian signing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Council of Upper Providence Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, in special session on the 24th day of June 2024, hereby authorize the Township to apply for an ARLE grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to study and enhance pedestrian safety around Rose Tree Elementary School and Walden School along Rt. 252 (Providence Road) between Preston Road and Sandy Bank Road.
