WHEREAS, Anna Tinsman and Alyce Thompson starting teaching Sunday School classes in the Tinsman Home. With the help of Ruth Kuder they wrote the Central PA's Board of Home Missions regarding the possibility of establishing a Lutheran Church in Media. Pastor Robert E. Anderson was sent to Media as Mission Developer in 1950 and the home of Alyce Thompson provided an initial meeting place.

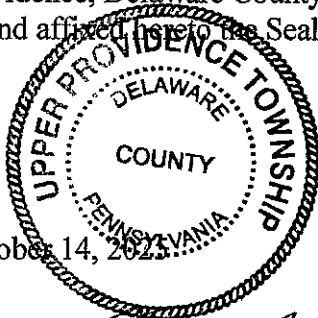
WHEREAS, On June 25, the first Lutheran Service were held in the original Upper Providence Township building. In May of 1953 a Groundbreaking was held for the Church School building and by November the new Church School was dedicated.

WHEREAS, The church continues to play a significant role in the community as it houses the Nursery School and Stay and Play Programs as well as welcoming many community groups for weekly meetings.


