Celebrating Fifteen Years of Lion's M.A.N.E.!



Lion's M.A.N.E., the senior citizen outreach program of the Rose Tree Media School District, is celebrating its fifteenth anniversary during the current 2019-2020 school year. This is a fact to be celebrated throughout the academic year! Below is a short history of how the name originated.

Programs for senior citizens had been in place in the school district for more than twenty-five years when the term "Lion's M.A.N.E." came into effect in 2005. At that time, Dr. Denise Kerr, Superintendent, thought of the term 'Lion's M.A.N.E.', with the acronym "M.A.N.E." standing for *Mature Adults Nurturing Education*. She thought this term would connect with Penncrest High School which has a lion for a mascot. Mature lions in nature lead the pride of lions and have a mane of fur which shows their wisdom and experience. Among the senior citizens of Rose Tree Media, Lion's M.A.N.E. members are leaders with wisdom and experience to share with students throughout the district.

The mission of Lion's M.A.N.E. was developed in 2012 by the Lion's M.A.N.E. Senior Advisory Council, a group comprised from the general membership of Lion's M.A.N.E. Revised in April 2019, the mission statement is as follows:

*Lion's M.A.N.E. offers opportunities
for older generations to interact with younger generations.*

Membership in Lion's M.A.N.E. is open to any resident of the Rose Tree Media School District who is age 65 or older. To join Lion's M.A.N.E., persons sign up at the district office at 308 North Olive Street in Media on any workday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Bring a photo ID and proof of residence. A Lion's M.A.N.E. Gold Card will be issued at that time. Membership is free for life as long as the person resides in the district.

Per Capita Tax Information - This Tax is Gone!

In May, 2019 a resolution was passed by the Rose Tree Media School District Board of School Directors to remove the collection of the 2019 Per Capita Tax and any future Per Capita taxes. NOTE: Any prior, unpaid Per Capita taxes in collection must still be paid and satisfied.

New Entrances at Each School

During the summer months, school building entrances were renovated to be more safe, secure, and efficient for visitors to enter each building. Visitors to each school enter through a designated visitor entrance and sign in with security staff at the entrance. Procedures used in previous years are still in effect including showing a valid photo ID such as a driver's license, obtaining a visitor badge to wear at all times while in the building, and returning the visitor badge when checking out at the same desk area before leaving the building.

Capital Planning Update

During the past two years, the district monitored the growth in student enrollment combined with an increase in housing developments. More students are projected to be coming to Rose Tree Media in the future. As a result, a study was conducted to determine if the capacity of existing school buildings was sufficient for the increased number of students. New Administrators in Rose Tree Media School District

Dr. Frances Garner was appointed the new Director of Student Services effective July 1, 2019. Dr. Garner has nine years of experience as Director of Special Education in North Penn and Central Bucks School Districts. She received her Doctorate from Immaculata University.

Dr. Tiffany Bendistis Orrin was appointed Supervisor of Transition Programs, effective July 1, 2019. This is a new administrative position. Dr. Orrin will work with teachers and students of special needs populations to help students master 21st century skills, something both colleges and employers seek. Dr. Orrin's work will ensure special needs students experience a smooth transition from graduating high school to moving to their next educational setting and/or finding meaningful employment as adults.

Dr. Vanessa Scott was appointed Director of Management Services, effective August 28, 2019. Dr. Scott has nineteen years of experience as a Business Manager for various school districts in Pennsylvania. She received her Doctorate from Rowan University. Dr. Scott is replacing Grace Eves who retired in early August 2019.

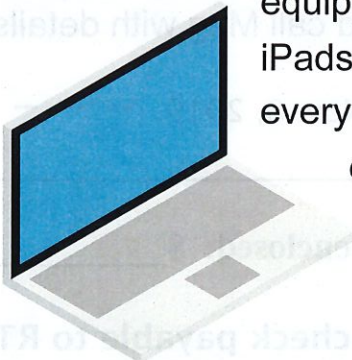


Technology Update

Rose Tree Media school district strives to offer its students a learning environment where the *21st Century skills* of the four "C"s - creativity, communication, critical thinking, and collaboration - combine with problem solving in all subject areas. Technology is used in each classroom as a powerful tool to support, expand and enhance the learning.

All computers within the district are networked with a high-speed connection to the Internet. This access is combined with interactive technologies, a Learning Management System, and teacher crafted web pages that guide, inform and support students. Current educational videos are available via video-on-demand services from the Delaware County Intermediate Unit through *Discovery Education*. In addition, students and teachers throughout the school system make use of a number of library databases to conduct research. The high school is equipped with a MacBook for every teacher, a Chromebook for every student, Tech Ed PC-based computer labs, a TV Studio, 3 Macbook computer carts, a Video production cart of 17 MacBooks, 8 PC desktop computers in the library, a projector in every classroom, and 26 interactive classroom Smart Boards.

The middle school is equipped with a MacBook for every teacher, a Chromebook for every student, 1 iMac Tech Center lab, 1 iMac Library lab, 3 carts of MacBook Airs, 25 iMac computers in the library, and interactive projectors in every classroom. Each of the four elementary schools is equipped with a MacBook and an iPad for every teacher, 6 iPads in every K-2 classroom, 12-13 Chromebooks in every 4-5 classroom, 2 carts of 25 MacBook Air laptops for classroom use, 2 mobile iPad carts for classroom use, 8 library computers, interactive Smart Boards and projectors in all classrooms.
